Ensuring Food Security



Many of our people are marginalized such as Tribal, landless, marginal farmers, agricultural labors, single women, informal labors etc. and do not have adequate social security. During the lockdown, they were away from their jobs for long time so it has impacted badly on their basic needs. To ensure their food security in these tough times, we have facilitated relief support with rations kits that lasted for more than month. The ration kit included wheat flour, rice, edible oil, sugar, tea powder, rava, poha, chana, turdal, Haldi, mirch powder, salt, bathing and cloth soaps, biscuits, khajur etc.

We have also facilitated with Govt. system for effective ration distribution from PDS shops.

Health, Hygiene and Safety

Around 500 women and girls are provided sanitary napkins which were difficult for them to access and afford in the lockdown.



Health of women has always been our priority



We have also provided total 300 N 95 masks to Covid 19 warriors such as health professionals of primary health centers and rural hospital, police, Asha workers and our women leaders from SHGs to ensure their safety to some extent. The initiative was supported by The Good Share Social Consultants.

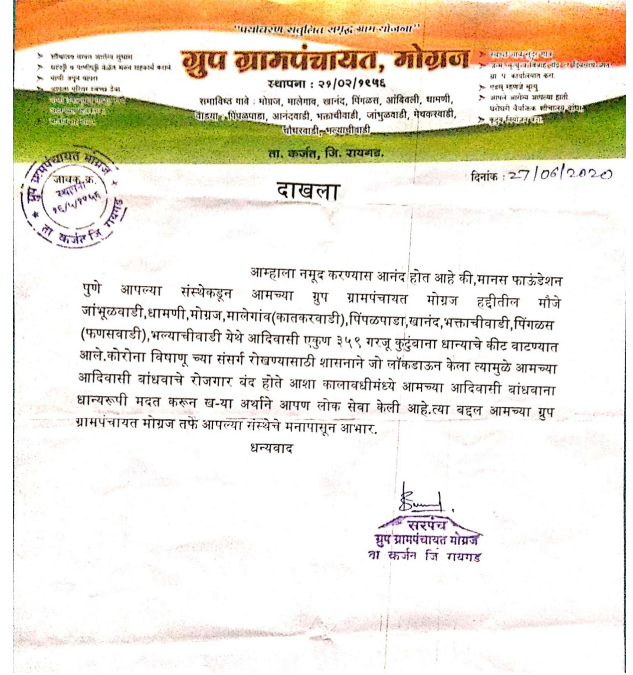
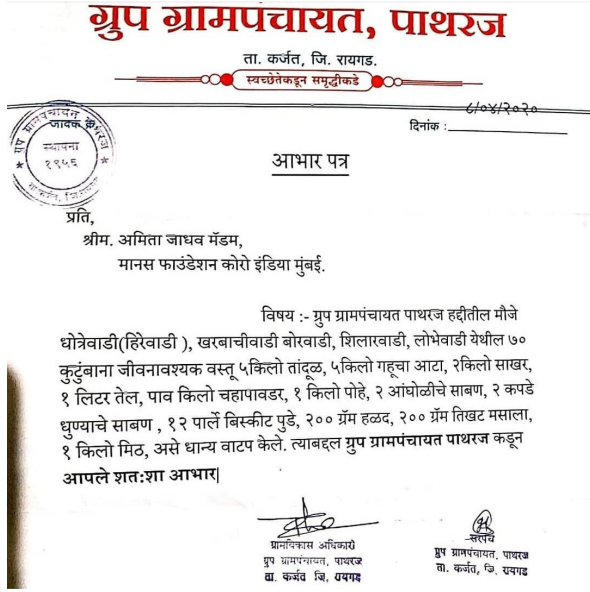
